Instructions for how to setup your fundraising page

Follow this guide to get your PeeForFree fundraising page rolling on <u>JustGiving.com/campaign/peeforfree</u>.



Set Up Your Fundraising Page

- **1. Go to the PeeForFree campaign page** <u>justgiving.com/campaign/peeforfree</u> Click the big orange "**Start Fundraising**" button.
- 2. Choose your fundraising style

You'll be prompted to pick one of these three options:

- "I'm taking part in an event" → Great for corporate or group challenges.
- "I'm doing my own activity" → For personal or DIY fundraisers.
- ∘ "I'm just fundraising" → Nothing specific, you just want to support the cause.
- 3. Customize your page
 - Pick a page name and fundraising goal
 - Add a team name (be bold, be funny, be you)
 - o Personalize your story: use PeeForFree campaign copy or write your own
 - o Upload a photo and set your target
